

Low Voltage Zone Control Instructions

To Install & Setup

- 1. Download "Brilliance Low Voltage Zone Control" app to the smart phone to begin
- 2. Choose a Magnetic AC transformer to provide 12VAC power to the Smart Dimmer and LED's. (A multi-tap will be helpful but not necessary)
- 3. Make sure the transformer is powered off when installing the 12 VAC LED dimmable products.
- 4. The two black wires on the dimmer get connected to 12VAC from the transformer. The two red wires get connected to the lamps or fixtures.
- 5. Power on the transformer to make the Smart Dimmer detectable in the app
 - a. Your blue tooth must be turned on
 - b. If no device appears, tap the arrow in the top right to refresh
- 6. In the app, go to the Menu in the upper left corner and select Setup, then select the specific Smart Dimmer that you would like to setup
- 7. Tap "Highest" and test that 12VAC (+/- .5 volt) is coming through the red wires. The reason for this is we want to compensate for the voltage drop through the dimmer.
 - In most cases you can put the transformer on the 13-14 volt tap and the output will be correct at 12VAC.
- 8. Tap "Lowest" and using a small Phillips screwdriver, adjust the trim pot switch so the LED's are at the lowest desired illumination.
- 9. Optional: in this menu you can choose to rename the Smart Dimmer
- 10. Tap "Disconnect" to exit and then tap "Home" to return to the main screen

To Adjust

- 1. On the Home screen select which Smart Dimmer you would like to adjust
- 2. A graphic will appear that you can use to adjust level up illumination by 10% increments
- 3. At the bottom of the graphic is a switch to turn the illumination on/off
- 4. Tap "Disconnect" to exit

To Group Multiple Smart Dimmers

- 1. You can do this from the Home screen by tapping "Groups" in the top right corner
- 2. Select all the Smart Dimmers that you would like to be grouped then tap "Connect"
- 3. Now anything you do from the "To Adjust" section will apply to all grouped Smart Dimmers
